He wrote <i>The Pilgrim's Progress</i>, arguably the most famous published Christian allegory. In the Church of England, he is remembered with a Lesser Festival on 30 August.</p> <p>Bunyan became a popular preacher as well as a prolific author, though most of his works consist of expanded sermons. In theology he was a Puritan, but there was nothing gloomy about him. The portrait his friend Robert White drew, which has often been reproduced, shows the attractiveness of his true character.
